Several members of the NHSLHA Board met this evening and discussed the position of NHSLHA representative on the NH Council on ASD. Putting the possibility of this position out to the NHSLHA membership has drawn significantly more interest than any other issue. Seven people have expressed interest in the position, which tells us that ASD is an area where we should be more active.

We all felt that this decision is too important to be rushed and that we need to meet the candidates, but we need to have someone represent NHSLHA at the NH Council on ASD meeting on Friday. We agreed to ask June Adinah, NHSLHA Secretary to represent NHSLHA at that meeting.

The plan that we formulated is as follows:

- 1. Invite all of the candidates to the next NHSLHA Board Meeting on Tuesday February 12.
- 2. Establish a NHSLHA Committee on ASD and ask all of the candidates to participate.
- 3. Vote on a NHSLHA representative to the NH Council on Autism and an alternate NHSLHA representative.
